



and a happy, healthy new year.







Charity & Community Outreach Activities

As much as the whole world reels itself yet another notch out of one of the biggest pandemic that the earth has ever seen, so has the metro Detroit community and our own state of Kerala.

However, we all know and accept the fact that the world still needs a lot of help, and Detroit Malayalee Association (DMA) as always, never shied away from its responsibility of reaching out to those who need assistance the most. We encourage all the DMA members and well-wishers of DMA to support us with our charity initiatives that we continue to do and help in every little way we can.

One of the first things, the 2023 DMA Team, kicked off the year was with community outreach activities and looking into the requests for helping the underprivileged.

The team did several projects and activities this year, which include the regular soup kitchen, food preparation, food serving and clean up at soup kitchens in the local communities. Other activities include Adopt-A-Road, which DMA does twice a year at Sterling Heights and Novi, Michigan. Also, one of our signature community support activities include Habitat for Humanity, which supports elder and senior citizens who need it the most.

DMA also has provided substantial help with monetary support for several deserving families during the entire year. Following were the five families DMA supported directly during the year.

- ❖ Anunand, a 7-year-old kid from Kozhikode, who is suffering from acute myeloid leukemia a type of blood cancer and is currently undergoing urgent lifesaving donor transplant.
- ❖ DMA also financially supported **Aruljothi Rexcinia** from **Coimbatore**, who is suffering from myasthenia gravis crisis a rare autoimmune, neuromuscular disease and a medical emergency that occurs when the muscles that control breathing weaken to the point where a ventilator is required to breathe.
- The family of **Biju Kodoor** in **Pala**, Kerala who are in dire straits due to an accident with no family income, was supported by financially by DMA.
- The family of Vijayan Pillai of Adoor, Kerala whose family of three are with no family income, and bedridden by an accident and spouse suffering from cancer were supported financially by DMA.





The family of Jose PV of Aluva, Kerala whose family does not have any income and all three members are bedridden, were supported financially by DMA.

Keeping the tradition with helping organizations and people here in metro Detroit, DMA made a financial contribution to the **Leukemia and Lymphoma Society**.


